

## Things to Bring to Winterall

### Everyone:

- Kindling and tinder for fire building event and friction kit

- Sled with cooler for storing dry clothes and water

- Bear bag and rope
- Patrol flag and yell
- Camping gear for Friday night, cold weather gear (Mummy bag and closed-cell pad), troop flag for opening ceremony, food for Friday night and Saturday morning
- Hand-held GPS unit

- Klondike sled for Webelos (optional)
