# Scout Day #1

Saturday May 1, 2010, 8:30am – 5:00pm

The Aurora Sportsmens Club, located in Waterman, Illinois is pleased to be able to offer area Boy Scouts the opportunity to complete shooting requirements for Rifle Shooting, Shotgun Shooting, and Archery Merit Badges. It does not matter whether you are completing a partial from time past—or trying to get a head start by working on the shooting requirements prior to summer camp, this is an opportunity you should not pass up. Whatever the situation—bring blue cards.

**Archery** – open range time from 10am to Noon. Check in at the archery range which is co-located with the shotgun range on Rueff Road to complete your shooting requirements. There is no cost for this program.

**Rifle** - \$10 fee to cover the cost of ammunition and supplies for 1½ hours of shooting. Three relays, 16 available positions per relay.

- Relay 1 - 9am to 10:15 classroom, 10:30 to Noon, range on Rueff Road
- Relay 2 - 10:45 to Noon classroom, 1:00 to 2:30, range on Rueff Road
- Relay 3 - 1:15 to 2:30 classroom, 2:45 to 4:15, range on Rueff Road

Check in at the classroom on Preserve Road 15 minutes before class time. Scouts need to provide own transportation to the range session (not walkable.)

**Shotgun** - \$40 fee to cover the cost of ammunition and supplies for three rounds of trap in three hours. Two squads, 5 available positions per squad.

- Squad 1 - 9am to Noon, trap field on Rueff Road
- Squad 2 - 1:15pm to 4:15pm, trap field on Rueff Road

Check in at the classroom on Preserve Road 30 minutes before class time. Scouts need to provide own transportation to the range session (not walkable.)



First-come, first-served registration by sending email with Scout's name, Parent's name and phone number; along with first/second choices of relays and squads to [BobMcLear@aol.com](mailto:BobMcLear@aol.com). All registration requests will be acknowledged. Fees to be paid at May 1 check in.

All classroom and firearms shooting will be completed under the watchful eye of NRA Certified Instructors and NRA Certified Range Safety Officers. The Guide to Safe Scouting rules and regulations are followed.

Ear and eye protection for firearms ranges and arm bands for Archery are provided by the club, but feel free to bring your own.
